He has worked at the **European Southern Observatory**, Munich, Germany (1989,1992-1994 as **ESO fellow**), the Observatory of Marseille, France (1994-1995, **CNRS fellow**), the **Max-Planck Institute for Astronomy in Heidelberg**, Germany (1995-1999), the **ARI Institute of the University of Heidelberg**, Germany (1998). Since 2000 he is working at the **Research Center for Astronomy, Academy of Athens, Greece**. He is Research Director since 2006 and Acting Director since 2009.

He has visited several institutes, where he has research collaborations like the University Louis Pasteur, Strasbourg, France, as visiting professor, the Excellence Cluster Universe, Munich, Germany as visiting scientist, the Southwest Research Institute, Boulder CO, USA, as Fulbright fellow, etc. He has supervised five PhD Theses at the Universities of Athens, University of Thessaly, Greece, University of Florida, USA and INOAE Mexico and seven Msc Theses at the .University of Athens. He has taught the postgraduate courses "Non-linear dynamical systems" (2007-2010) and "Extragalactic Astronomy" (2011-2019) at the Department of Astronomy University of Athens.

He has co-authored more than 63 refereed papers and has more than 60 contributions to conference proceedings and special volumes. Co-editor of 3 volumes of conference proceedings, has participated in 53 international meetings giving 49 talks and presenting 4 posters. Has given 22 invited talks in conferences and seminars in research institutes and university departments. SOC member in 12 conferences and workshops. Main organizer of 4 conferences and two series of seminars (MPIA, Heidelberg and RCAAM, Athens).
